OUTLINE

Students will rotate through four teams that work on Your Morning

MORNING TEAM

Student will work with our morning news team and will have the opportunity to do the following:

- Write news stories
- Observe in the control room to learn how a show goes to air from a variety of positions
- Observe live in-studio as the show goes to air
- Help set up live demo, kitchen segments

NEWS PRODUCING TEAM

Student will work with our news producing team and will have the opportunity to do the following:

- Pitch news interviews and guests
- Prepare research
- Chase guests
- Conduct pre-interviews
- Accompany producers on any field shoots
- Shot list video
- Sit in on an edit
- The student may be able to work with a producer to pitch, produce and see their segment through to air

FEATURES PRODUCING TEAM

Student will work with our features team and will have the opportunity to do the following:

- Pitch feature interviews and guests
- Prepare research
- Accompany producers on any field shoots
- Shot list video
- Sit in on an edit
- Assist in preparation for a demo segment
- Write some of our packaged features such as The Week Ahead and People to Watch
Work with our production coordinators to source video, graphics and other production elements

DIGITAL TEAM

Student will work with our digital team and will have the opportunity to do the following:

- Work with the team on posting articles and video to our website yourmorning.ca and posting to our social accounts.
- Work with the team on creating special web-only features such as On This Day and cutdowns of live show moments.
